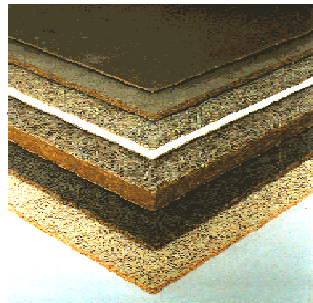

Second Eltomatic CVS-16 to be installed at Celenit, Italy

Eltomation is currently finalising the manufacturing and final testing procedures for the supply of the second **Eltomatic CVS-16 Rotating Wood Wool machine** to Celenit, Italy. The order for this second machine was received based on the satisfactory operation of the first Eltomatic, which was supplied to Celenit one year ago. The 2nd Eltomatic will become operational at Celenit immediately after the summer holidays.



Eltomation to supply 3 WWC Plants to PAEP, Jiangsu Province, PR of China

Eltomation has recently obtained 3 orders from the party "Wuxi Pan-Asia Environmental Protection Technologies Ltd." (PAEP), Jiangsu Province, PR of China.



The project includes the following 3 plant types:

- Phase IV Wood Wool Cement Board WWCB / EltoBoard Plant;
- Expandable WWCB Plant;
- **Fully Automated Production Line for Large WWC Elements** (being the first of its kind in the world). The Large Element Line will enable the production of up to 1.000 m² finished Wall Elements (of 40 cm thickness) per day, good for up to 1.200 housing units per year.

The project is a new green field operation near Yixing City, Jiangsu Province and will consist of 3 turn-key production lines to be installed side-by-side. The plants will be located inside 2 new buildings of 180 x 80 m each, on a plot of approx. 9 HA. The first Plant (WWCB/EB) will become operational by September 2010, to be followed by the 2nd Plant (WWCB) in April 2011 and the 3rd Line (Large WWC Elements) in July 2011.

PAEP expects to further expand its WWCB activities in China during the next years.
